

Quality-based GIS data is the core of any Local Government Geospatial program, and the foundation for any successful Enterprise GIS. One of the most important aspects of a robust GIS is regularly updating and maintaining the local foundational datasets. Sanborn has developed specific processes and quality standards based on our extensive experience and discipline-wide best practices. Our goal is to provide you with not just updated data, but data that can grow to meet the needs of your municipality. We do this in the following ways:

- → Utilize standardized databases that track feature-level attribution including sources and history and meet state-level parcel standards.
- → Update parcel geometry using best practices, including coordinate geometry (COGO), georeferencing, and digitizing for more accurate parcel lines
- → Maintain a quality control link between your parcel data and your Assessor's database
- → Provide actionable information by spotting errors in the data, and identifying untaxed or undertaxed property.
- → Keep coincident and related layers in sync by efficiently updating them at the same time

Sanborn will assist your municipality in updating your foundational data layers and Tax Assessor's Maps, so that you can be confident that your GIS data is ready to keep your staff and citizens informed, your business systems integrated, and your decisions sound.

The Annual Foundational Data Maintenance program will update your parcels and associated tax map information, as well as update several existing foundational map layers such as zoning, street centerlines, address points, and open space areas. The exact layers to be maintained will be determined and defined for your managed services program based on existing data and practices in place.

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As an added step, we will perform multiple quality control checks, and provide you with Quality Assurance (QA) analyses reports to help improve your parcel data going forward. Your Project Manager will provide you with additional guidance on each step of the process prior to beginning the annual foundational data maintenance.

While the Annual Foundational Data Maintenance benefit is available to all Spatial IQ for MapGeo customers, clients may 'opt-out' of this service. This information will be identified in your Quote's Subscription Details.

The time you spend coordinating and responding to these requests adds up and can become burdensome and disruptive to your work day. As a benefit of your Spatial IQ for MapGeo subscription, Sanborn will help solve that problem by securely hosting your most commonly requested data online, making it available for download to those with the appropriate credentialed permission.

Standard data to be hosted and downloadable may include any layers that are currently available on your MapGeo website. Tax Assessor PDF maps may also be made available as hosted, downloadable files.

Having a strategy with realistic short and long-term goals, will help you get the greatest return on your geospatial investments by avoiding duplication of effort, and making sure your program is useable, useful and used throughout all the departmental day-to-day tasks and decision-making. As part of the subscription, Sanborn will meet annually with GIS stakeholders and decision-makers to plan and prioritize goals based on YOUR municipal needs.

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We will review our existing understanding of your situation, consider what our other similar clients are doing, and ask your stakeholders for input through an online survey. Depending on your current environment, we may consider existing GIS software, data, and business systems to explore how new integrations might work, what data you may want/need to develop in the coming year and try to identify and understand your organizational and technical priorities. All the information we compile will be presented to you in the form of SWOT Analysis that highlights our understanding of your Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats. We'll also present to you a set of recommendations designed to fill the largest gaps or take advantage of the biggest opportunities identified in our analysis. Wish you had a clone of yourself or a larger team of in-house GIS staff, but are not able to make that a reality? Because full-time, in-house GIS staff is sometimes not feasible for many municipalities, or if you're just looking to augment your existing GIS staff to proactively keep raising your Spatial IQ, this service assists you as an additional resource without the full costs, IT, HR, hardware, software and training that comes with adding new municipal staff.

Depending on the tier you choose, Sanborn professional staff will provide a set number of dedicated hours each quarter for achieving your GIS goals. The Improving tier offers 8 hours per quarter of support, and the Advancing tier provides 24 hours per quarter, annually. The Advancing tier takes advantage of a lower blended rate that is built into your package - more bang for your buck!

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Some of the tasks we can work on include, but are not limited to:

- Software Updates (GIS Software)
- Custom Cartography
- MapGeo, Desktop GIS software and conceptual geospatial training
- Geospatial Data Development

The goal of the Spatial IQ for MapGeo program is to enable your Spatial IQ to grow by *proactively* moving it forward throughout each year with known services that will help accomplish that mission. However, there are really no limits to how far you can take your geospatial program and we want to support you all along the way.

There are bound to be special geospatial tasks, services, and projects, that do not fit neatly into the managed services tier package items described above, or you may want more support than is "out of the box" with your chosen tier package. Sanborn is happy to provide any additional, special services or projects on a time and materials basis, within a budget that you define. These can further enhance any of the tier benefits, and/or provide unique support for specific projects. Some examples might include, but are not limited to:

- A fieldwork or in-office data development project, such as capturing all stormwater network features, or georeferencing all of your Right of Way scanned plans
- Custom cartography or calculations for a municipal meeting or report
- Custom database integrations between your GIS and permitting or other business systems
- Ad hoc assistance in GIS related network management issues
- Assistance in methodological development of data maintenance policies and procedures.

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- Assistance in specifying GIS staff roles and responsibilities and in recruiting and/or interviewing GIS staff
- Facilitation of workshops, planning, whiteboard exercises
- Performing an audit of existing GIS assets, programs, and data
- Attendance/client representation at GIS planning/coordination meetings

The special projects tasks may be engaged on an ad-hoc basis, or they may be defined and prioritized during your Annual Strategic Planning Meeting. If they're identified on that prioritized roadmap, it will help define how Sanborn tackles each of them throughout the year. Talk to your Project Manager to coordinate these special projects. All Special Projects will be invoiced monthly, on a Time and Materials basis, per our standard schedule of rates.
